2022 Watermain Flushing Update to Schedule

Municipal water users are advised that the flushing or swabbing of drinking watermains will take place this Spring as follows:

Flushing Schedule Update: Monday to Friday only between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

- Port McNicoll began May 9 anticipated to be completed by May 20, 2022
- Waubaushene beginning May 24 for approximately 2 weeks
- Rope Subdivision area beginning June 13 for approximately 5 days
- Victoria Harbour Completed
- Midland Bay Woods and Easton Avenue Completed

As a result of this work, you may experience a change in pressure and/or some discolouration, sediment in the water, or perhaps even <u>no water</u> for short periods of time.

Should you experience discoloured water, following a flushing event, run your cold water for 10-15 minutes to clear the service line. If the water does not clear after this time, turn off the tap and wait 30 minutes and repeat the process.

Water use during the scheduled flushing periods should be kept to a minimum to avoid discolouration from entering your home or business. During these times, it is advisable to check the water prior to doing laundry.
